The diversity of flowers in these illustrations is amazing. From a water garden to a cactus garden, then follow the 4 seasons with a garden for each; add in edible, rock, rose, bulb, fragrant, pastel, cascading, shaded foliage and more. This book is truly a flower lovers dream.1. 30 pages with 27 (3 are 2 page) Illustrations printed front and back of 15 pages on medium weight, bright white paper.2. For use with Colored pencils, Sharp crayons could also be used,3. I tested Pentel markers, Fiskars

and Irma Gel pens and they leak through the paper.⁴ Some of the images have some areas of the pictures that lack detail, just a few lines depicting trees, bushes, flowers, etc., some of these areas are in the background and some in the foreground. This is an art technique kind of like a photograph with a blurred area. It can be challenging to color but can also be fun to practice this technique with colored pencils.⁵ All of the flowers are listed on the bottom of the page so you can look them up if one is not familiar to you. Illustrations include the following: An autumn garden, An early Fall Garden, a Cascading Garden, Vegetable Garden, Shaded Foliage Garden, A Succulent Garden, A Pond Garden, A Rock Garden, A Container Garden, Everlasting Garden, Spring Garden, A Blue and White Summer Garden, A Climbing Garden, A Suburban Garden, A Butterfly Garden, Garden overflowing with color, Rose Garden, Summer Garden in full Bloom, Spring Bulb Garden with a bunny, Fragrant Garden, Water Garden, Summer Garden, Cactus Garden, Pastel Late Summer Garden, Winter Garden, Edible Flower Garden, an Arrangement of garden flowers.

This isn't my favorite coloring book. I find it a little hard to "read" the line drawings. Leaves and stems filling in the background are more indications than actual shapes. Also, while the flowers themselves are pretty, the overall garden layouts don't thrill me. They seem unplanned and haphazard, making it harder for me to plan a color palette and so forth. I wind up being dissatisfied with the finished page more often than not--which isn't the case with the other flower garden book I've reviewed. That said, it's still a Dover coloring book, and you can't go far wrong with that.

These are great to play around with in Photoshop or Illustrator. Just scan as black & white line art at 300 ppi. In Photoshop use the paint bucket, or in Illustrator use live paint. We printed some as t-shirts and notecards. Fun projects especially for kids.

I just purchased these Dover COloring Books for my mother and she loves them. The detail is out of this world and the variety of colors you can use are only limited by your inagination. **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED!**

I got 7 of these books and love coloring them. You can get really creative. I don't have an artist's talent, so I enjoy creating my own color combinations, although there are colored pictures of all of them on the covers so you can follow those or come up with your own. These aren't not kids coloring books! They are more detailed, and I use colored pencils on some, fine point gel pens on others and a wide range of felt tip colors on most. I usually do these in the evening when I need to

wind down and they work wonders for me. Even without artistic talent, I love my renderings.
