

Fr. Cameron is an excellent author. I've read several of his books and have heard him talk on numerous occasions and so I was anxious to see his take on Pope Francis and his guidelines for

preaching. Unfortunately, this book was a little thin. Not only is it only 54 pages, which barely qualifies as a book, the material likewise is lacking. The text primarily consists of direct passages quoted from Pope Francis' apostolic exhortation, *Evangelii Gaudium*, with very brief comments by the author on the most pertinent parts. After reading the exhortation itself several times this book does not provide any new insights or inspirations. The commentary provided by the author is simply too brief and lacks the depth of some of his other works. What this book feels like to me is a handy quick reference guide to the papal exhortation. *Evangelii Gaudium* is a lengthy work and it could be very difficult to find a specific quote within it. This book cuts out the excessive wordiness of the papal text and provides the most important references to preaching found within it. As such it should be considered less a commentary than a reference work. For a priest or deacon looking for a quick read to help inspire and clarify their preaching this text seems capable of fulfilling that need. For someone interested in learning about Pope Francis or his theology it is preferable to read his own books, speeches and homilies which are readily available online.
